To Whom It May Concern:

Starting effectively April 1, 2008 the City of Ozark, Missouri will be enforcing mandates from the State of Missouri on soil erosion and sediment control. It will be the responsibility all of permit holders to make sure that the soil erosion and sediment control is in place and maintained. The following items will be initiated in this process.

1. A soil erosion and sediment control inspection shall be conducted by the City of Ozark, prior to any land disturbance or fill.
2. All requirements on the erosion control plan shall be implemented and installed properly.
3. Failure to request or pass the inspection will result in a stop work order, citation and or potential legal action.
4. Soil erosion and sediment control measures will be monitored by the Public Works Department, Building Department and MDNR.
5. Soil erosion and sediment control measures must remain in place and maintained through the entire construction process.
6. Periodic inspection will be done by the City of Ozark, Missouri at any time. Failure to maintain soil erosion and sediment control measures will result in a stop work order and summons.
7. Sediment and debris must be contained to the site.
