




# Pedestrian Friendly

- 7.5 Mile Proposed Trail Connecting Springfield to Ozark
- 17 Easements / Property Owners Along the Preferred Alignment
- Only 11 Easements Remain
- Connects Numerous Historical,
   Cultural & Natural Amenities
- Provides Multi-Modal
   Transportation to Several Nodes of Activity
- Planning Began in 2016
- If Approved, Over 25% of the Chadwick Flyer Will Be Constructed by 2021








## **Project Highlights:**

- Provides direct connectivity to the Ozark Community Center










- Provides Grade Separated

- Project Completed in Conjunction with HWY 14 Improvements











## **Project Highlights:**




